MODE OF DELIVERY AND INSTRUCTIONAL STRATEGIES

a. Instructor – Direct Training and Supervision. The curriculum spells out number of hours the instructor and trainees are together face to face in class. These are termed as contact hours. During this time trainees are elaborated on the subject matter of the course/programme.

b. Instructor – Trainee Learning by Doing. The curriculum spells out clearly the number of hours the instructor and the trainees spend on hands on practical training, production and innovation by performing tasks. These are called practical hours. The trainee does practical work with the help of the Instructor or independently.

c. Dual Training approach. Dual training system means a type of education system that emphasizes training at a Technical or vocational institution and the world of work. It is called dual because the training takes place in two venues: At ACCT and the work places. The learner/trainees are trained at ACCT for a specific period and join the world of work through Industrial Training or Apprenticeship to work and train from the company/work place.

d. Study Tours. Exposure Study Tours are very essential for the training and part of the core approach to competence base training. The academic departments at the college organize study tours for their trainees and instructors to visit various fields related to their academic programs. The college is in the process of buying a 40 seater bus that will enable the trainees conduct the study tours conveniently and at leisure. The bus is being procured with the assistance of the parents and well wishers contribution.

ODEL: Open Distance E-Learning is a flexible training and learning system with continuous physical and Online engagements between the trainer and trainees. The trainees are given comprehensive hand outs and references, guided on tools and regular Online assignments. The trainees are scheduled for at least two weeks of face to face with the trainers and supervised assessments. The target groups are the working class engaged in work similar to the very programmes to be register for at Diploma level. The **ODEL** apply to both hard and soft skills training.

Weekend and Recess Sessions are conducted for only those who are employed. A trainee who wishes to undertake this mode of training shall prove to the college administration that is employed or is a practitioner.

OTHER INFORMATION

Reporting to the college: The dates for reporting of the new students joining ACCT is indicated on the admission letter. On reporting the new student has go to the office of Academic Registrar with the required documents. A students registration number is given and a file opened. The student is there after referred to the Bursar for payments and processing of the School Pay code. After all these processes, the student becomes a genuine trainee of ACCT.

Internet Connection : The college has full time Internet connected to the computer labs, class rooms, workshops and offices and students hostels using Local Area Network (LAN) and WiFi. The learners and trainers are encouraged to equip themselves with Smart phones, lap tops and other IT devices to do research, develop artificial intelligence devices and applications.

Personal Tools: Parents must provide the learners with uniform for particular programmes eg. Engineering: overall/overcoat, gumboots, helmet, gloves; Hotel and Tourism: Black Trousers or Skirt, coat, tie and white shirt; Journalism: jackets. Overcoat and Aprons for other departments. All labelled ACCT. These items can also be accessed at the college at a cost in the department of Tailoring Fashion and Design. Also needed are personal tools, equipment and materials relevant for the enrolled programmes.

ACCT Business Incubation Centers - BICs were established to boost the students practical training, industrial and apprenticeship training and real life projects and production. The Centers are Models for the learners to acquire skills and experience relevant with the world of work. They guide the trainees in entrepreneurship skills to start and run own business after training. The BICs at the same time serve the public and generate income to the departments for sustainability. ACCT established a lead organisation **COMFORT VILLAS LTD for** Hotel and Tourism training and services, Contract for Building and Construction, Financial Services, IT Services, Fashion and Design supplies, furniture making, transport services, contracts for other engineering services eg Plumbing work, Electrical and solar Installation, painting, roofing, interior design, terracing, smart homes devices etc. Comfort Villas Limited engages the students to participate in all the mentioned activities in order to improve on their skills and competences and learning by doing.

Bursaries: The college provides bursary of the following category:

Term. There are three terms in an academic year. Trainees under term system pay fees three times a year. The category are Technical certificates plus Hotel and Institutional Catering Certificate study in terms therefore pay fees where it is indicated per term.

Semester. There are two semesters in an academic year. Trainees who study under semester system pay fees two times a year.

Payment of school fees. School fees is made to the ACCT bank accounts only through School Pay system. A student is assigned a payment code that has is used to log in the payments of the fees. To pay dial: **Airtel *185*6*2# MTN *165*4*3*1#**, then select pay school fees, enter students code. The college is not accountable for monies paid through cash, individual mobile money or other means other than School Pay.

Parents who may not afford paying full amount of fees at the beginning of the Semester/Term pay at least half (50% of the total amount) at the beginning of the semester/Term and full payment (100%) before the end of the 6th week of a semester or 4th week of a term.
